ABOUT OUR SCHOLARSHIP

The Southport Lions Club will offer a \$1,500 scholarship annually known as the Lion Charles Sunder Scholarship (and in some years may offer more scholarships if possible) to a South Brunswick High School Senior who plans to further his/her education. The scholarship will be based on need and preference will be given, but not limited, to a visually and/or hearing impaired student. Academic achievement, character, service, and potential for growth will be taken into consideration. The scholarship is not renewable and the funds will be distributed to the academic institution the recipient attends on behalf of the student. The winning applicant must submit documentation showing enrollment at the institution in order for disbursement of the funds.
